Directions to the Liberty Water Plant for Training:

Take M291 south out of Liberty, MO to Ruth Ewing Rd; turn west. Turn south at Birmingham Road. Continue south to the plant entrance at Arsenal Road and left at Riverview Road. Turn right into the plant. (see map attached).

Description:

The City of Liberty Wastewater Treatment Plant is an activated sludge treatment plant with a lift station, screening, two activated sludge treatment trains with biological phosphorous and nitrogen reduction, secondary clarifiers, UV disinfection, sludge aerobic digesters, with land application of sludge.

The presentation will include experiences of startup of Liberty Solids Handling processes. The discussion will include startup and lessons learned of the plant's MTAD Process (Membrane Thickening Aerobic Digestion) and Dewatering system startup and dewatering polymer selection process.
